

Local Work

This publication will give you an insight into the latest developments in regeneration, economic development and governance. 10 issues per year.

CLES Bulletin

The Bulletin provides a summary of a topical policy issue. 10 issues per year.

Rapid Research

Rapid Research provides swift and incisive analysis of policy trends and developments, and explores their relevance to regeneration practitioners. 4 issues per year.

Enquiry Service

on community engagement, or look for the latest publications about regional strategies - we can answer the most specific and individual of queries with a turn around time of 3 working days. The subscription covers 4 enquiries a year.

Members' Website

You can download free of charge all previous and current CLES publications. You can also access responses CLES has made to a variety of government consultations.

On-line Library

Containing over 14,000 items including books, reports and articles, the online library can help you with your own research. You can search the site and receive items on loan. Subscription covers up to 10 requests a year.

Bespoke Services

About CLES


